SUBJECT: Oval Sprint Ski Clarification

- ISR is aware that the regional rules for the SWC series has removed the requirement for using a mandatory Right Hand ski that featured a turned down edge/ to control the direction of the roost emanated from the ski in cornering.
- After the study was completed it was observed that although the deflector changed the direction of the discharge it did not totally remove the visibility and striking fellow riders with debris as originally thought.
- This year that style of ski is still a legal ski, and if used the system of measurement that was used to check overall width will continue to be used.
- If the vehicle has two conventional skis the overall width is 45" inches, if it is using one of the deflector style skis, the width with the deflector may be up to 45.5 inches. (45 1/2 inches).
- So, the actual teching process will not change from last year concerning the 45-inch overall width.
